Ord. 18	1/1/1913	Providing for the incurring of indebtedness by this Borough of Millbourne in the sum of \$8,500 for constructing sewers and for other general public purposes.

Ord. 30	6/15/1914	Providing for the increase of the indebtedness of the Borough of Millbourne in the County of Delaware and State of Pennsylvania in the sum of \$1,500 for the purpose of purchasing the real estate and improvements thereon of the Millbourne Fire Company situated on the East side of Park Avenue in said Borough.
Ord. 37	6/21/1915	Providing for the increase of indebtedness of said Borough in the sum of \$6,000 the issuance and sale of bonds to represent said indebtedness; providing for the application of the proceeds thereof for the purpose of the construction of a Borough Hall.
