**Message from the Tax Collector Md. Uddin**

Dear Millbourne Tax Payer: First and foremost I want to thank you all. The good news is almost every property owner paid their Borough tax during the discount period. May 31 is the last day to pay both taxes (property and trash and sewer). If you do not pay on time additional fee will be added to your bill. So, as a reminder to you, please pay your bill on time! Also if you move, change your mailing address; you must contact the tax office in Media to update the information by calling 610-891-4273 and also the Borough office at 610-352-9080. **Animals in Millbourne**

Please do not let dogs or cats out alone without being leashed. Animal Control will be called and the animals will be picked up. Please clean-up after your pet. Fines will be issued for failure to clean-up. All dogs and cats from 3 months or older must have current rabies vaccination. All dogs 3 months or older must be licensed by Jan. 1 of each year. There are license applications at the Borough office. The Bureau of Dog Law Enforcement located in Harrisburg will work with Delaware County Animal Control to check on vaccinations and licenses. Do not leave food outside for animals. Pets should only be fed inside their home. Animal Control will be called and you could lose a pet.

**Gardens in Millbourne** must be weeded and maintained and may not cover the whole front yard. **Please keep the size to ¼ of the yard.** No pumpkins or other spreading vegetables may be planted in front yards. No vine growing up frames may be planted in front yards. Plantings in the back must also be kept under control and weeded.

Your trash is your responsibility. Do not use small flimsy bags, trash in heavy duty bags or cans with secure lids. If trash blows onto your property, it becomes your property. The Borough will start to give warnings to those who do not follow healthy practices regarding trash. Tickets will also be issued to those who repeatedly cause potential messes. Recycles only are to be put in the yellow barrels. Warnings for those who use yellow barrels for trash and tickets will also follow. If you put the recycles in a small bag and close and place in the bins, when it is winding the recycles will not blow around as much. Please do not throw trash over the fence on Wister Dr. Millbourne wants to continue a good relationship with

Septa. On Market St several plants have been planted and stones/rocks are around them, please do not place trash cans or bags on top of the plants.

Please, if you rent or sell to a person that does not speak or read English, you need to contact the office. In an emergency we need to know who can be called for these residents. Ignoring notices from the office because a resident does not speak English is no excuse.

The County of Delaware is once again cooperating with the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection as well as Penn State Cooperative Extension in an effort to track West Nile virus by performing adult mosquito surveillance. Traps will be placed in various locations throughout the County during the late afternoon by Penn State staff, and will be picked up the following morning. If you would like to see what a trap looks like, please visit Borough Hall, or the website. Don't grow mosquitoes! Empty: kiddie pools, buckets, watering cans, trash cans, anyplace where water can collect, will breed mosquitoes.

**Many of the sewer problems with properties in Millbourne are caused by residents putting wet wipes and other trash in toilets. Please put only toilet paper in the toilet.**
