Changes have happened in the laws regarding what can be put out for trash pick-up. The laws were made by the State of PA.

Please do not put mattresses out for bulk trash pick-up unless the mattress is wrapped in plastic. The Borough is trying to find inexpensive plastic covers.

Please do not put out any building materials or left over wood and other construction materials. The Borough is looking into where the materials can be taken. Please contact the office to ask for information. The office number is 610-352-9080, Monday to Friday 8:30 am to 3:30 pm

The yellow plastic cans are for recycling only. If unsure what can be recycled come to the office and receive a chart that shows items. Notice of Violation will be issued and if the violation continues a ticket will be issued.

Please DO NOT put TV's out for the trash, as they will not be picked-up. Millbourne Borough will be working on what to do with TV's. You may call and leave your name at the office and you will be contacted.

If there are smoke detectors in your apartment you may not remove the batteries. Landlords are required by law to have them in apartments. State Law now requires carbon monoxide detectors in non-owner occupied residential buildings.

If you have concerns about activity going on, please dial 911 and request Delaware County 911 and ask for Millbourne Police, it does not need to be an emergency. The police are not interested in immigration, only in safety.

A message from our Tax Collector Md Uddin: To All Residents: Thank you to the residents who have paid their property taxes and the trash and sewer fees. **IF** you have not paid the 2016 property taxes, or the trash and sewer fees, they are seriously overdue. So, I am requesting that you promptly send in the payments immediately. Your action is urgently needed so more late fees do not occur. This is the last time you will be notified. A message from our Borough Engineer: Millbourne is an MS4 Community. Everyone needs to do their part to not pollute the streams. "ONLY RAIN GOES INTO THE STORM DRAIN". If anyone is interested in having a

rain barrel, which can collect rain water from a rain spout please contact the office. The rain water can be used to water plants or other uses.

Leaf clean-up is the responsibility of all residents. Please **Do Not** put leaves in the street and clean-up in front of your property. Put in trash cans or bags for collection. Please **Do Not** wait for leaves to blow down the street or off your property. Storm drains need to be kept clear.

Warning! Basement apartments in Millbourne Borough are illegal. If the kitchens are not removed, and vacated, legal action will be taken.
